Winners will be invited to attend a joint meeting of the Lions/Lioness Club.

One \$200 scholarship for a student of Filipino ancestry with a minimum 3.5 GPA and excellent resume. Student must plan to attend a 2 or 4-year university. Financial need and Filipino background is a must! Attendance at the ***Spring Luau with the organizations is required. Current unofficial transcript required.***

**FOR THE LOVE OF THE GAME – JAMES ROBERT RAMOS**

One for \$500 for a student that has played football for all four years of high school and is a well-rounded individual in academics, athletics, work experience and/or community involvement.

**HANNALU FAMILY**

Two for \$750. Minimum GPA 2.50 and plans to attend a college, university, or trade school in the upcoming academic year. Must be involved in at least two different extra-curricular activities and have financial need. Additional consideration for those with a history of part-time employment, church involvement and/or community service

**HIGHWAY ONE REALTY**

Two for \$500 for students with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plan on attending college, vocational school, or military after high school. ***Include a short statement on future goals.***

**JOHN BELL MEMORIAL**

One for \$500 for a male with academic and leadership ability.

**LOS OSOS VALLEY GARDEN CLUB**

One for \$500 for a student with financial need and initiative in preserving and caring for the environment with career plans in the field of horticulture or related field. Include a short summary of ***“Ways I have protected and made the environment better while in high school and ways my future educational plans contribute to the protection and improvement of our environment.”***

**MABLE VIERTHALER MEMORIAL**

Four for \$10,000 for students that show academic potential for success and demonstrate motivation and desire for advancement and opportunity. This scholarship is a multi-year \$2,500 scholarship. **MORRO BAY ATHLETIC BOOSTERS**

Four for \$500 for students with 3.0 GPA or higher that have participated in at least one sport per year of high school. Must intend to enroll in a two year, four-year college or trade school.

**MORRO BAY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

Three for \$250 for students that have financial need, commitment to continued education, and who have held part time employment or been involved in extra-curricular activities. Preference will be given to business majors.

**MORRO BAY COMMERCIAL FISHERMAN'S ORGANIZATION**

\$1500 # varies for conscientious students who has proven his/her capabilities to meet life's challenges by making sensible choices. It is desirable that his/her high school education and experience has included a wide range of diversity. ***Include a typed description of your qualifications, including but not limited to, future educational goals, and why you feel you qualify for one of these scholarships.***

**MORRO BAY CROSS COUNTRY**

One for \$250 for a student that has been a participant of the Morro Bay High School Cross-Country team during their senior year.
