One for \$1000 for a student who has outstanding work in the arts in an area of music, graphics, photography, theatre or shop during the last two years of high school. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 and has had no disciplinary school suspension. **Include a typewritten one-page biographical sketch on "Why I Desire to Obtain a College Education", an unofficial transcript and three letters of recommendation; one from a school administrator or counselor; one from a subject-matter teacher; and one from a person not connected with the school.**

One for \$1000 for a student that has been doing some scouting and community service activities during the senior year. Must have an cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better and a 3.0 during the senior year Must have no disciplinary school suspension and have demonstrated an awareness of community responsibility. **Include a typewritten one-page biographical sketch on "Why I Desire to Obtain a College Education", an unofficial transcript and three letters of recommendation; one from a school administrator or counselor; one from a subject-matter teacher; and one from a person not connected with the school.**

Priority will be given to graduates in 1) CTE goal employments, 2) apprenticeship program/vocational education program, 3) community college license/certification program, 4) related college major.

### **CJ AND CB WALKER**

One for \$500. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. **Include an essay (three paragraphs) in response to the following: "How have you been influenced in the development of your plans for the future by a great thinker and achiever such as Newton, Copernicus, Einstein, Shakespeare, Beethoven, Washington, or your parents, a friend or a current teacher?"**

### **CALIFORNIA RETIRED TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (CRTA)**

Four for \$1000 scholarships for students planning to enter a 2 or 4 year college. Applicant must have a 3.5 unweighted GPA and high ethical & moral qualities. **Include two letters of recommendation from faculty, and copy of current official transcript**. Finalists will be interviewed by the sponsoring organization.

### **CAPTAIN MICHELE ROWLEY LEARY MEMORIAL**

Two for \$500. Prefer that applicants be pursuing a degree in marine biology (or similar study) or the field of teaching. **Include an unofficial transcript and a brief typed essay on the following questions: "Describe the greatest obstacle in your life. How did you overcome it?" Scholastic or non-scholastic, if you could pick one activity that you enjoy the most, what would it be? Why do you enjoy it so much? Explain why you need financial assistance to attend college".**

### **CAYUCOS GARDEN CLUB**

Four to Six for \$500. Must be a Cayucos resident.

### **CAYUCOS LIONS/LIONESSE CLUB**

\$1000 (# varies) Must be a resident of Cayucos and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be involved in activities or sports. **Include one letter of recommendation from a teacher and a short autobiographical essay on where you are from and your goals**. **DOMINIC RIOLO MEMORIAL**

Number varies and ranges from \$1000 to \$5000 for a students majoring in Journalism, Communication Studies, English, Political Science or International Relations. ***Include an unofficial transcript, ACT and/or SAT scores and a copy of a page from your college application(s) indicating intended major. Include responses to two essays. Essay prompts are available in the College and Career Office.***

**DOROTHY M. BERRY MEMORIAL**

One for \$500 Must be planning on studying sculpture or painting at the college level. Minimum GPA of 3.2.

**ED SPERA VOCATIONAL**

One for \$250. Must be planning on attending a business, vocational or trade school (must not be attending a four year college) and have financial need. ***Include an essay on how you demonstrate motivation and desire for achievement and opportunity.***

**ELAC – ENGLISH LANGUAGE ADVISORY COUNCIL**

Amount and number varies. Must be an English Learner or a student that has been reclassified as fluent English proficient (previously an English learner). Requires a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Student may be planning on attending a 2-year, 4-year or vocational/technical school.

**ESTERO BAY WOMEN'S CLUB**

Two for \$500 for females in good academic standing that have participated in school and/or community activities.

**RUTH PERRY MEMORIAL/ESTERO BAY WOMEN'S CLUB**

One for \$1500 for a female with a 3.0 GPA that has participated in school and/or community activities.

**FILIPINO WOMEN'S CLUB OF SLO COUNTY**

One \$250 scholarship for a student of Filipino ancestry with a minimum 3.5 GPA and excellent resume. Student must plan to attend a 2 or 4-year university. Financial need and Filipino background is a must! Attendance at the ***Spring Luau with the organizations is required. Current unofficial transcript required.***

**FOR THE LOVE OF THE GAME – JAMES ROBERT RAMOS**

One for \$500 for a student that has played football for all four years of high school and is a well-rounded individual in academics, athletics, work experience and/or community involvement.

**GIRL SCIENTISTS ROCK** – Two \$1,000 awards for female students pursuing a BS degree in Environmental Science.

**HANNULA FAMILY**

Two for \$750. Minimum GPA 2.50 and plans to attend a college, university, or trade school in the upcoming academic year. Must be involved in at least two different extra-curricular activities and have financial need. Additional consideration for those with a history of part-time employment, church involvement and/or community service

**MABLE VIERTHALER MEMORIAL**

Four for \$10,000 for students that show academic potential for success and demonstrate motivation and desire for advancement and opportunity. This scholarship is a multi-year \$2,500 scholarship. Total value over four years is \$10,000. The scholarship will be annually renewable if eligibility is maintained by enrolling and completing an average of 12 units per semester/quarter with a GPA of 2.5 or better while in college. Selection Criteria: Applicant must be planning to attend school as a full-time student at an approved vocational school, community college or four-year university and has demonstrated involvement in their school, work, and/or community activities throughout their high school years.

**MANKINS FAMILY**

Two for \$500. Must have work experience in the hospitality industry. For example, have you worked in a restaurant, hotel or retail business? ***Include a 2/3 paragraph essay on "What are some of the most important aspects in the hospitality industry and why".***

**MARGUERITE UNGAR MEMORIAL VOCAL ARTS**

One for \$250 for a student that likes to sing and has been in choir at least one year in high school. Student must plan to enroll in some form of post-secondary education. ***Include a two to four paragraph essay in response to: "What does singing mean to you and how do you plan to share your love of vocal music with others?"***

**MORRO BAY ART ASSOCIATION**

Six for \$500 for students that have a passion for art. ***Include supplemental essay questions available in the College and Career Office.***

**MORRO BAY ATHLETIC BOOSTERS**

Four for \$500 for students with 3.0 GPA or higher that have participated in at least one sport per year of high school. Must intend to enroll in a two year, four-year college or trade school.

**MORRO BAY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

One for \$750 for a student that has financial need, commitment to continued education, and who have held part time employment or been involved in extra-curricular activities. Preference may be given to business majors.

**MORRO BAY COMMERCIAL FISHERMAN'S ORGANIZATION**

\$1500 # varies for conscientious students who has proven his/her capabilities to meet life's challenges by making sensible choices. It is desirable that his/her high school education and experience has included a wide range of diversity. ***Include a typed description of your qualifications, including but not limited to, future educational goals, and why you feel you qualify for one of these scholarships.***

**MORRO BAY MUSIC BOOSTERS - BAND**

One for \$500 for a student planning on involvement with music at the post-secondary level, preferably as a major or minor. ***Include a one page essay on "My plans to Continue with Music Education and Why".***

**MORRO BAY MUSIC BOOSTERS - CHOIR**

One for \$500 for a student planning on involvement with music at the post-secondary level, preferably as a major or minor. ***Include a one- page essay on "My plans to Continue with Music Education and Why".***

**MORRO BAY PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION**

One for \$300 to \$500 for a student planning to enter into the field of public or community service. Preference given to those entering into law enforcement or emergency service. Minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. ***Include a one-page written statement on: "Why you deserve this scholarship".***

**MORRO BAY WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB**

Amount and number varies for students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher that have been on the MBHS Girls Golf Team. The student must plan to pursue a full time education at a two or four-year college or vocational school. ***Include one letter of recommendation from the golf coach.***

**MORRO VALLEY ASSOCIATION**

One for \$500 for a student who has a minimum GPA of 3.0 and has strong involvement in community service, agriculture and leadership. Must be attending a two or four-year college or vocational/trade school.

**P.E.O. CHAPTER KA – PHILANTHROPIC WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION**

Multiple scholarships of up to \$1000 for females with a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA who have demonstrated involvement in their school, work, and/or community activities throughout their high school years. **TOM SIMMER MEMORIAL**

Four for \$500 for students with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA that are preparing to attend a two or four year college or university. ***Include an unofficial transcript and essay on: "Why do you deserve this scholarship?"***
