Once a Runner, by John L. Parker Jr.

Quenton Cassidy is a competitive distance runner with the lifelong dream of running a four-minute mile. His life changes dramatically when becomes involved in a protest against the Vietnam War and he's suspended from his college track team .

Wolf by Wolf, by Ryan Graudin

This is the first book in a duology about an alternate ending to WWII, and a motorcycle race that takes place in 1956 to commemorate the Axis Powers' victory. The story begins on a train as the book opens in 1944...

When, by Victoria Laurie

Maddie Flynn is sixteen years old. She has a 'gift'. She cannot help but see the death date of everyone she meets (or even sees in a photo or onscreen) ... But when Maddie predicts the death of a young boy, she becomes the center of an FBI investigation.

Shatter Me, by Tahereh Mafi

It is never too early to reach out to your student's teachers to introduce yourself and begin to develop the communication chain. Make sure to check teacher websites, and begin to familiarize yourself with what your student will be required to do to be successful in each of their classes.

I also encourage you to use the fresh start of the semester to develop good study habits at home. Set aside a specific time at night when your student will share with you what homework they are completing, what they did at school that day, etc. Simply talking about school shows the importance you feel about your student's success. Powerschool is a wonderful tool to leverage as a parent. I also encourage you to set aside a specific day or time that you check your student's grades. As crazy as it sounds, I check grades and discuss it with my two girls on the evening that the trash has to go out to the curb! It just helps to remind me to check on their progress and see if I need to talk with them, their teachers, a counselor, etc.

Lastly, I want to again thank everyone for their support and flexibility during our Measure D construction. I am so excited for our students as these completed projects happen.
