## Dance Regulations/Guest Passes

- ❖ To provide a safe and positive environment at school events, MBHS administration reserves the right to deny admission to anyone.
- ❖ Activities are for MBHS students and their invited guests. Guest permits may be obtained from the School Receptionist and must be approved in advance by the student's School Administration.
- ❖ Guest passes will be issued to school activities under the following conditions:
  - The guest must be at least a 9<sup>th</sup> grade student at the time of the event.
  - If a high school student: The guest must be in good standing at their school of residence.
- ❖ Any student currently expelled from any school will not be eligible to attend an MBHS function.
- ❖ High School age students who have dropped out of school and have not re-enrolled in an educational program will not be granted a guest pass.
- ❖ A student or guest who leaves an activity may not return.
- ❖ Drinking, smoking, or use of illegal drugs will not be allowed. If any student or his/her guest is suspected of being under the influence of a controlled substance, the parents will be notified and/or the student or guest may be referred to law enforcement officers and taken into custody.
- ❖ MBHS students must have a valid MBHS I.D. Card to attend.
- ❖ Guest must also have a photo I.D. such as a driver's license or school I.D. Card and a completed guest pass.
- ❖ All students and guests must comply with all MBHS/San Luis Coastal Unified School District guidelines and policies including all aspects of the dress code.
