During the past six years, the poverty rate for students attending Morro Bay High School has risen from 20% to 44%. One of the ways that change manifests itself is in an increase in the number of students needing basic necessities like food and clothing. In an effort to assist the students in the communities of Los Osos and Morro Bay, a clothing closet has been established. Called "Pirate Plaza" and located at Morro Bay High School, the clothing closet provides students with clothing, socks, underwear, and basic toiletries (including clothing for school dances). Pirate Plaza accepts donations of new or gently worn teen appropriate clothing including jeans, t-shirts, shoes, and sweatshirts.
