



PROM CONTRACT

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This year's Prom is on **Saturday, April 8, 2017**, at the **Pavilion on the Lake**, 9315 Pismo Ave, Atascadero, from **7:30pm to 11:00pm**. The cost for a single ticket is **\$50**, & two tickets is **\$95**. Free photos are available from ShutterBooth. The Junior-Senior Prom traditionally is one of the highlights of the school year. At Morro Bay High School, the expectations of parents, community, administration, staff, and student body are very high. To ensure that ALL students will enjoy the Prom in a safe, positive, and orderly environment, the following guidelines will be enforced:

1. The Junior-Senior Prom is a school activity, therefore, all school rules and discipline codes will be in effect and enforced. **Note: any violation of the drinking/drugs rule will result in a 5-day school suspension and a 42-day activity suspension. If there is suspicion of drinking, student or guest will be asked to take a Breathalyzer test administered by our School Resource Officer.**
2. We strongly encourage that no motel or hotel room be rented for student use.
3. Students and their guests agree to dress appropriately in a manner that is in keeping with the formal decorum of a high school Prom. The administration reserves the right to refuse entrance to a student in clothing which is too revealing, too sloppy, or does not meet with the following dress code:

LADIES: Formal dresses, evening dresses, cocktail dresses or fancy pantsuits. No jeans or tennis shoes will be permitted.

GENTLEMEN: Tuxedos can be worn, but are not required. Suits and ties or sports coats and ties are fine. No pullover sweaters, jeans or tennis shoes (even with zoot suits) will be permitted.

The Prom Committee must approve any attire other than what is specified above, such as: prom theme, ethnic clothing, and cowboy tuxedos. If you find you cannot meet the dress code, please see Mr. Allstot or Mrs. Abuan and the Prom Committee for help or approval of your clothing **before March 24, 2017**.

4. The Prom is a school-sponsored event, in conjunction with the Junior Class, and is under the jurisdiction of the school staff and administration. Students, and their guests, attending the prom, are to conduct themselves according to established DISTRICT and SCHOOL expectations. (Refer to Student Handbook).
5. Student participation is strictly voluntary and a privilege.
6. No entry will be permitted into the Prom after 9:30pm. If a student and/or guest leaves the Prom, they will not be allowed to return.
7. The Morro Bay High School administration reserves the right to refuse to sell a ticket to, or admit any person who does not adhere to this contract.
8. Students or their guests who fail to abide by these established guidelines will be asked to leave the Prom and be dealt with in accordance with the established DISTRICT and SCHOOL policies.
9. Every MBHS student must complete this contract, and return it to Mrs. Abuan in Room 502 **before a ticket can be purchased**. If you wish to bring a guest, **the guest pass on the 2nd page sheet** must be filled out before the contract is turned in. Guests not in school must fulfill the requirements at the bottom of the second page. Guest passes need 2-3 days to be processed.
