

CTE Pathways need to be taken in sequence. There are three types of courses:

- Introduction: A CTE entry level course that contains concepts and skills required to build foundational and general knowledge. Not every pathway has an intro course.
- **Concentration**: An intermediate level course that is designed to provide more in depth instruction and exploration of a specific pathway.
- **Capstone**: The most advanced and final course in a pathway that provides a rigorous and intensive culmination of study.

In order to be a pathway completer, you must take 300 or more hours of CTE instruction in a specific pathway and earn a C or higher in all pathway courses. Use the QR Code below to access Morro Bay High School registration information



Dual Enrollment (CCAP)

Some of our CTE Pathway classes are College & Career Access Pathway (CCAP) courses which are dual enrolled classes with Cuesta college. That means, you would complete a class at Morro Bay High School, but you would receive Cuesta College and high school credits concurrently. You must complete the Cuesta College enrollment process in order to be officially dual enrolled.

Multiple Pathway Completer Students are able to become completers in multiple pathways as long as they finish the coursework and meet all requirements.
