Ten \$6,000 scholarships awarded to high school seniors who have demonstrated service to LGBTQ (lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender/questioning community) such as involvement with Gay Straight Alliance activities. ◆ ***Alan D. Stephenson Scholarship***

The Alan D. Stephenson Scholarship was established to support promising LGBTQ students to achieve their academic potential. This is a 4-year award with a total of \$10,000 available to honoree.

◆ ***Alfred I., Catherine J. & Elenor Switzer Scholarship***

This scholarship was established to benefit youth of Los Osos, CA. The applicant must be dedicated to attending full-time at a four-year college and to pursue a bachelor's degree in any of these fields: applied or fine arts, architecture, engineering, mathematics or science. The applicant must demonstrate financial need, a strong academic record and a leadership role in the community or extracurricular activities. One \$16,000 scholarship to be awarded over 4 years.

NOTE: Applicant must have attended Los Osos Middle School

◆ ***Burt W. and Virginia Polin "Elks" Scholarship***

The Scholarship Committee will award one merit-based \$2,000 scholarship for a high school graduate pursuing a degree in public safety. The scholarship is based on the Elks tenets of: charity, justice, patriotism, good fellowship & service.

◆ ***Douglas DeGross Automotive Studies***

The Douglas DeGross Scholarship provides support to graduating seniors who are pursuing a career in the automotive industry. The applicant must be committed to pursuing a post-secondary education specializing in automotive studies. The scholarship committee will award on \$2,000 scholarship.

◆ ***Gary Grossman Scholarship- for LGBTQ community***

The Gary Grossman Scholarship was established to provide post-secondary scholarship assistance to high school or college students who are gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender. Awards will be at least \$1,000 and up to \$5,000.

◆ ***Gary Paul Piantanida Scholarship***

The Scholarship Committee intends to award a multi-year \$3,000 scholarship, with a total value of \$12,000 over the four years. Merit, school/community service and financial need.

◆ ***Helen and Ronald Dunin Legacy Scholarship***

The scholarship supports first generation students at public high schools in San Luis Obispo County. Applicants must attend full time at a four-year college, have demonstrated financial need with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 and a maximum of 3.7, on a 4.0 scale. The Scholarship Committee intends to award a multi-year scholarship with a total value of \$12,000.

◆ ***Kelly A. McAdams Scholarship***

Established to honor the memory of Kelly A. McAdams, a graduate of our local schools and a life-long student with an inquisitive mind. One \$10,000 divided over four years.

◆ ***Martin Resorts Scholarship***

The purpose of the Martin Resorts Scholarship is to support the children of Martin Resorts employees planning to continue their education after high school. The scholarship aims to recognize student leadership and achievements. Two for \$1500.

◆ ***Maureen “Mo” Clancy Memorial Scholarship*** Applicant is currently a senior girl at a San Luis Obispo County high school, planning to attend full-time at an approved community college, four-year college or vocational school. Scholarship value of \$2,000.

◆ ***Sera Day Coryell Nursing Education Scholarship***

This scholarship supports graduating seniors attending high school in San Luis Obispo County. The Scholarship Committee intends to award one \$2,000 scholarship that may be annually renewed providing that the student is making satisfactory progress toward **Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program** requirements and maintains a 3.0 GPA.

◆ ***Richard J. Weyhrich Leadership Scholarship***

The Richard J. Weyhrich Scholarship Committee would like to award at least \$2,500 to \$5,000 scholarship at each SLO County comprehensive high school. This scholarship comes with recognition from the SLO County Board of Supervisors and a medal. If you are involved with your school or community, and demonstrate leadership potential, this is for you!

◆ ***Scholarship and Mentorship Scholarship***

The scholarship’s purpose is to provide financial support for current or former foster youth who are participating in Family Care Network’s Independent Living Program. Total award value will be dependent on recipient’s post-secondary institution and enrollment status.

◆ ***The Garris Family Scholarship***

The applicant must be dedicated to attend any post-secondary education, full or part-time. Applicant must have demonstrated need for financial aid and Pell Grant eligibility, with a minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.7 and a maximum of 3.7, on a 4.0 scale. Awards will be at least \$1500 and up to \$10,000

◆ ***Vineyard and Farm Workers Scholarship***

The Vineyard and Farm Worker’s Scholarship supports higher education for the children of vineyard and farm workers. The applicant must be committed to pursuing a post-secondary education at Allan Hancock College, Cuesta College or California Polytechnic State University-SLO. The award will be multi-year and dependent upon years attending technical school or college/university.

◆ ***The Scholarship and Mentor Scholarship***

The purpose is to provide financial support for current or former foster youth who are participating in Family Care Network’s Independent Living Program. Total award value will be dependent on recipient’s post-secondary institution and enrollment status.

◆ ***Yeager Science Scholarship***

This scholarship was established to provide support to students with the purpose to make a positive impact in the life of the recipient. It is targeted for those who are economically/culturally disadvantaged, and would find attending college difficult. The scholarship focuses on students intending to major in physical science and related fields at Award will be \$23,000 over four-year period.
